

Wirrina Bluegrass festival and COVID

We are blessed that we are in the position that we can enjoy the Wirrina Blue Grass festival, despite some limitations resulting from the COVID pandemic. In order to protect our festival participants and the wider community, we kindly ask you to respect the (minor) limitations and regulations put upon us.

The below is an informal synopsis of a number of issues relevant to the festival and is not necessarily complete. For comprehensive information, please consult official information as provided by the SA government via public channels. You may also consult the COVID-SAFE plan of the Wirrina caravan park available at the office.

- **Physical distancing** - Maintain 1.5-metre separation. This does not apply to those who attend as a group, such as members of the same household, family, or people who otherwise regularly associate with each other.
- **Hand sanitising** - at various locations in the caravan park and festival area, hand sanitiser stations are set up, and these must be used when entering/using that location.
- **Contact tracing** - Please check-in using the QR code system or the sign-in sheets at the festival office or the caravan park office.
- **Mask wearing** - A face mask is required when in common indoor areas (eg. toilet, kiosk etc). All relevant areas will have yellow signage indicating the mask requirement. Please note that the main stage area, the blackboard session tent, and most workshop venues as classified as outdoors. There are some exemptions to mask-wearing (eating or drinking, age less than 12 years, relevant medical condition etc). Please note, however, that indoor singing is NOT exempted from mask-wearing unless it is part of a scheduled performance.
- **COVID marshals** - As mandated by government regulations, volunteer COVID marshals are monitoring whether COVID rules are being adhered to. One of their tasks is to remind you of applicable rules. Please follow the instructions of these volunteer COVID marshals who can be clearly recognised by their lanyard tags and other indications on their attire.
- **COVID symptoms** - If you have symptoms of COVID (fever, cough, tiredness, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, etc.), please leave the festival, seek testing for COVID, and follow medical and regulatory instructions. Please also inform the festival organisation and/or caravan park management
